

Boarding School Tuition and Fees

For those parents and guardians not wanting to go through the Financial Aid process, annual tuition for boarding students is as follows:

\$36,000 annually

This includes everything except uniform charges, college testing/application/housing fees, some courses taken in 9-12 grades that are for college credit, medical insurance (if HHFA must provide), personal hygiene products, spending money for field trips and outings, and weekend breaks, Thanksgiving break, and Spring break, if your student must stay with a sponsor family. All students will go home during Christmas break and a summer break. If a student is unable to be at home during this time, additional charges may apply.
